### **What additional facilities are available?**

- **Networking:** Meet and greet with alumni, executives and professionals from relevant sectors who would share their professional experiences and provide valuable career guidance
- **Internship:** Interested participants, based on available opportunities, will be connected with relevant organizations for practical experience in the industry
- **Study Tours:** The program will arrange educational and fun industry tours for all the students to learn how projects and programs are run and how the day-to-day activities are undertaken in the real world
- **Seminars / Workshops:** Program participants will get opportunities to participate and

contribute to the seminars and workshops organized by the Department of Economics, JnU.

### **Where can you apply your skills?**

The programs emphasize on critical thinking and problem solving skills of the young professionals who are willing to pursue their career in government organizations, international agencies, NGOs, research organizations, think tanks, consultancy firms, business firms, financial institutions, and multinational companies. The program will also develop both hard and soft skills for creating and managing social businesses.

A dynamic group of renowned faculties from the Department of Economics, trained nationally and internationally, along with esteemed professionals with strong sector knowledge and teaching experience are engaged in teaching the economics and development studies courses.

### **How this program is structured?**

- Program duration: 1 year(2 semesters)
- Registration validity: 2 years
- Required number of courses per semester: 3-5
- Required number of credits for graduation: 42
- Thesis: 3 credits (optional)
- Class duration: 3 hours
- Class days: Fridays and Saturdays

### What is the teaching and learning process?

The program follows interactive learning strategy which is basically a combination of lecture and relevant activities. About 50-60% of each course will comprise of theoretical learning and the remaining 40-50% will be dedicated to application of the theories including case studies, group works, presentations, discussions etc.

Guest speakers with extensive industry experience and knowledge will run sessions on relevant topics

### What are the eligibility criteria?

#### ME

- Minimum Honors in Economics, Statistics, Mathematics and Business
- Minimum CGPA of 2.5 or equivalent

#### MDS

- Honors / Master's with Pass course (any subject)
- Minimum CGPA of 2.5 or equivalent

- Transcripts and certificates from each post secondary institution attended
- Application fee of Tk 500.00
